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



So, the low down on taming the mane based on the latest trends is here ... before it hits the shops in the Autumn season. In the line-up for the hottest hairstyles to look cool during Fall, there is something to suit every fashionista's mood. Asgar Saboo explains the best ways to get each look...



The Blunt Bob The blunt bob look is fun and sophisticated; with no layers and cut all at one length, you can achieve the volume you have always dreamed of. It is feminine and mature, drawing attention to the structure of your face and really elongating that neck. To understand how it looks, look at Beyoncé and young stars like Margot Robbie and how they wear theirs for some inspiration. This look is so versatile - the blunt bob can

how they wear theirs for some inspiration. This look is so versatile - the blunt bob can be styled with a side or middle parting, or simply slicked back off the face. Don't underestimate this look, whether you want to channel your inner Hollywood goddess or not. Today we're seeing bobs that hit just above the shoulders, so the style can be worn long enough to tie in a ponytail. Note that the blunt bob works well for straight and wavy textures, so you can really make this your own.



Side Ponytail The side ponytail is often dismissed, but it actually is a very elegant and formal style that can be worn to any event. Side ponytails work best for long hair for the ponytail to sit over the shoulder. You can wear your ponytail straight, curly, wavy, with braids or twist – there are so many ways to style it. My personal favorite is a sleek side ponytail with a quiff or fringe for a lively, voluminous look. Young stars like Cara Delevingne wear theirs on the top of the head, but keep yours at the nape of the neck if you want to look chic like the Duchess of Cambridge.

Bohemian Waves 🖉

This sultry style gives effortless but lustrous definition for volume and life to any hair type, color or texture, which is the perfect complement to the Bohemian fashions we're predicting for Autumn. These effortless waves work best on mid to long length hair, creating lots of natural movement. To get your bohemian waves ready for Fall, apply mousse to your wet hair and blow dry until you meet your natural hair texture. For bohemian waves I suggest you follow your natural parting. Starting from the bottom take various sized sections of hair and wrap around a curling wand. The hair near your face will have to be curled outwards away from your face to keep with the Boho feel. : Spray your locks with a hair mist for texture and volume; add a salt spray if you want something extra tousled.



Accessorise your look

A look which dominated the Fall catwalks was the use of clips and barrettes. No longer the territory of teenagers, Proenza Schouler and Fendi put headbands on their models for vintage glamour, while other designers went for barettes and extravagant clips. Take your pick from the wide range, but we recommend you choose something in a neutral toned color to look playful but sophisticated.



Tying the knot

Forget about buns for this season, because it's all about the knot and getting an undone look. You can style this right on top of the head or the nape of the neck depending on your mood, just make sure it looks effortless and like you've just piled this on your head. If you find this difficult to achieve, then we recommend tying the knot loosely and pulling out a few strands to make sure you're on trend. Fix with a light hairspray so the style looks flawless all day.

> rom Game of Thrones to the Terminator as Genisys, British actress Emilia Clarke is fast becoming one of the most recognizable faces in : Hollywood. Driven by her role as dragontoting Game of Thrones vamp - Daenerys Targaryen, the London-born actress went from a small part in Doctors to charming Jude Law in 2013's Dom Hemingway in the blink of an eye. Appearing now in her latest venture as Sarah Connor opposite Arnold Schwarzenegger in Terminator: Genisys, the 28 years old actress is set to cache the mantle of action-heroine in one of the most iconic films, in a role previously played by Linda Hamilton. The role for which, she says, she had to do a lot of gun training with military advisers because she really wanted to "beat the boys" and prepared herself for stunts with a grueling regimen to get into shape for the role - a work ethic that impressed the Terminator icon, Arnold Schwarzenegger. First Avenue met her for an exclusive interview at the very distinguished and chic Bristol Hotel in the French Capital, and talked to her about : her roles on screen and the fame it garnered.



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How did it feel becoming an international icon all of a sudden, as Daenerys Targaryen in the complex medieval series Game of Thrones? I don't believe I am an international icon. And you know, whenever I go out on the streets with my partners in Game of Thrones, Kit Harington and Peter Dinklage, people ask me to take photos of them with the actors, meaning that they don't recognize me at all. Mainly due to the blond wig I wear in Game of Thrones, people hardly recognize me. So you see I am everything but an icon.

You have performed the role of Daenerys Targaryen in the Game of Thrones for many years and now as the resilient warrior Sarah Connor, do you believe that you need to break your image?

Not at all. I am not the least interested in breaking my image. In fact, I love my image. What I would appreciate though is having the opportunity to get more and more roles in cinema like it happened with Terminator: Genisys.

Did you enjoy taking over the part of Sarah Connor in Terminator: Genisys?

I did more than enjoy it. You know, I grew up watching Terminator and I never imagined becoming Sarah Connor, originally played by Linda Hamilton. Now there is one who is truly iconic, not me! It was a privilege to audition for this part, and a bigger one to get it.



Did you try to imitate Linda Hamilton ? No, especially not, I created my own character as that is what actors do.

Did you meet Linda Hamilton to discuss the matter with her and maybe get some advice?

Unfortunately, no. No one helped me doing that or even getting her phone number. I would have loved it though.

And how about James Cameron, did you have the opportunity to meet the man who created Terminator in the eighties?

Well, believe it or not, I never met him

either. I was just happy to learn that he loved our film and appreciated our work, me and my fellow comrades, the other actors.

Did you go back and revisit the earlier movies, in which Linda Hamilton played Sarah?

I already knew intimately what she'd done. But when I really read our script, it's so different. It would have been a waste of time to go back and try to replicate what Linda did, because of the fact that we go way back into Sarah's childhood to change forever the woman she would turn into.

What was the most difficult thing to do during the shooting of Terminator: Genisys, was it to appear with no clothes on in the middle of the highway?

That was not easy indeed. And my father is not happy at all with these scenes. I tried to explain to him that they were necessary for the understanding of the plot, but I hardly convinced him. No, in fact the hardest thing to do was to carry all those very heavy weapons and walk and run with it on my back and shoulders.

Regarding what you say about your father, it makes it clear why you turned down the part in Fifty Shades of Grey.

Oh, I believe that if I had done that, my daddy would not have spoken to me ever again.

How about Arnold Schwarzenegger, how was it facing him in front of the camera?

I was impressed but he knew how to make me comfortable by keeping things very simple and behaving as if he was not the icon he is. In fact I was more impressed by his human and humble behavior.

What would you like to change in : your life, had you the opportunity

to go back in time the way your character in Terminator: Genisys does?

Nothing at all. I am a very happy person and very grateful for all that is happening to me. And what's more, I am not so sure going back in time in order to change the future would be such a great idea. What to change and what not to change? That's a very heavy question.

Yet for the fun of it, what period would i opportunity of coming back soon. you like to visit?

: For the fun of it? Then let us say the roaring twenties! They seemed to have fun in those days.

Why are you limping?

I broke my foot while practicing a Break Dance exercise. I shall get over it quickly.

Too bad you will not be able to enjoy Paris with your broken foot. Yes, I regret that. But I hope I shall get the

The brother sister duo revitalizing British high fashion...



ueled by an ambition to make history, Christopher Kane partnered up with his sister Tammy Kane to build a fashion house and the

Kane Label has certainly achieved that goal. Today, the brand is recognized as the one that helped revitalize British high fashion. This season Kane reworked the designs of the 2007 collection and dedicated it to the late Central Saint Martins MA

professor, Louise Wilson. The collections

- features coils, cord and rope and
- these have become the insignia on his

collection, and the way they seem to flow across a fabric, blending the coil twists with fragility, erupting tulle from cones fashioned from fabric, or just simple cascades of tulle down the front held by metal clips, which Christopher Kane calls, 'controlled explosion'. The aesthetic that defines Kane's sense of style is an abstract conceptualization of patterns and motifs albeit with a personal touch. Christopher's process of drawing and his technical skill lies in the way he transforms the simple elements of life, familiar motifs and patterns to add a touch of subversive elements

and chic boldness that define his sense of style. Neon colors, lace from neon vinyl, traditional embroidery motif and patterns on vinyl and leather suggest the blending of timeless with the ephemeral and the sleek with the subversive, the sinister with the sweet. Which is why, people say that Christopher Kane's designs are all about a woman's attitude not her age; they evoke the image of a tough girl with a playful and strong emotional heart. Christopher talks to us about the brand

NARS, his latest Collections & products and his inspirations...

What was your creative process in developing the Christopher Kane for NARS Collection? Was it similar to creating a seasonal collection?

I wanted the collection to reflect key signatures from Christopher Kane and therefore based the color palette on iconic artifacts brought together from our past collections. The NARS collection was more retrospective; celebrating the history of the brand from past to present day, we wanted it to be a timeless representation of the brand, and not limited to a particular season.

We've noticed that neon is weaved throughout this beauty collection, why was it important for you to include this style element in the collection?

Neon is a huge part of the Christopher Kane identity, so much so that it has become a neutral. In order to truly express the nature of the brand, there was no question that it had to be an integral part of this beauty collection.

How have you utilized neon in your collections?

I've worked neon into the collection in such a way that it complements the face while still communicating the bold neon impact. It was very important that we make the products wearable, for example the lip glosses in neon shades - you can see they are brightly colored in their glass bottles, then once on the lips they have a high translucent shine with a subtle neon stain. I wanted a harmonious balance between the bold and beauty.

Do you have a favorite product and color?

I love the Violet Atom Illuminating Multiple, the color has this unusual ethereal celestial beauty that makes it so unique and the multiple is so versatile.

I am so excited to be opening our very first store and in London - this is the first time we will be able to interact directly with our customer and really get to know and understand them. The entire process has been amazing, and I have really enjoyed it every step of the way. We worked with

Do you have a go-to inspiration source, something that inspires you again and again?

I have always worked on instinct and with what surrounds me on a daily basis. I have never searched for inspiration, as I don't feel this works, I like for inspiration to find me it's a very natural and personal thing.

How has the Christopher Kane brand evolved over the past few years? Where do you see the brand in the next 5 years?

The brand has grown so much over the last years, most significantly since we partnered with KERING. There is still a lot of work to be done but we are working hard to achieve these goals and are certainly on the right path and with the right partners. KERING has been such an enormous support to us and now with the opening of our first-ever store in London this March, it is such an exciting and huge step for both the brand

How has your upbringing contributed to your artistic creativity?

The landscape of my childhood and my upbringing have certainly had an influence on my work. I love that I can call on certain characters from my childhood as a source of inspiration but most importantly, it is the strong work ethic which was instilled in me by my family from a very young age that I am grateful for; I was raised knowing that in order to succeed you have to work hard and fight for what you want and believe in.

You are in the process of opening your first boutique in London, what has that experience been like?

John Pawson, a brilliant British minimalist designer whose work I love and admire, and who made me feel extremely comfortable throughout. John and his team are wonderful and so lovely to work with and instantly understood what I wanted to achieve with the store, which has made for a wonderful experience.

You are known for producing clothing that is "wickedly original" with unexpected concoctions and playful patterns—do you think this collection portrays your signature aesthetic? Every season I like to do something that feels new and different, whether that be through the innovative use of textiles, a cutting technique or experimental fabrics.. this has become signature to the brand and to how I work -- the Spring Summer 15 collection very much reflects that approach

Why did you decide to work with Nars? Why now?

NARS has been a long-standing and valued partner of ours, so this collaboration was an obvious fit. NARS has the same bold and creative aesthetic that is signature to the brand and I'm excited to share what we've created together.

Can you tell us about the color palette for the collection, are these signature Christopher Kane colors?

The color palette is based on artifacts brought together from our past collections, like our signature safety buckle and bolt fastenings. These artifacts naturally communicated three Christopher Kane color themes; our classic bold neons, our brand shade of nude and futuristic iridescence. These colors are signatures of the brand and we wanted to represent that in the purest sense.

Can you tell us about the final products you selected for the collection?

It is a full color collection featuring products for eyes, lips and cheeks and combines NARS' iconic and bold beauty philosophy with our design aesthetic.

THE LONG & THE SHORT **OF LOSING HAIR & GAINING IT**

irst Avenue interviewed Dr. Lars Skioth, the founder of Harklinikken (the hair clinic) in Denmark to get an insight into the major causes of hair loss and how

• to resolve the dilemma of losing such a • significant feature, because twisted, curled or braided, in updo's, waves or ponytails... hair says a lot about who you are. Hair is a very dynamic and versatile feature and it has the potential to enhance your image, your beauty and ultimately your self-esteem. So, we talked to Dr. Lars Skjoth, a scientist with a strong interest in human nutrition and biochemistry, who has devised individually customized treatments for the hair and scalp to ensure re-growth of hair. He has established a series of hair restoration clinics in Denmark, Germany, the United States and the latest, in Dubai.

The Harklinikk (hair clinic) offer individualized treatment for hair loss using a treatment system and a range of products developed through extensive research and clinically tested to treat androgenetic alopecia and physiological hair loss. Using these pioneering techniques, Dr. Lars Skjoth has worked with 60,000 clients from three continents over a period of two decades. Currently, Dr. Skjoth is in Dubai, though he visits Academic Alliance in Dermatology on a quarterly basis to see patients and oversee the Harklinikken operations in the • United States.



Tell us about yourself and your background?

My background is science of human nutrition and biochemistry. For the last 23 years I have focused my studies on hair loss disorders and ways to remedy these problems by addressing each client's hair problem individually, and customising products and treatments.

For the past 7 years I have been doing new research with one of the leading specialists in the USA, Dr. Vasiloudes, whose specialty is Dermatology. Our research is conducted in our laboratories in Tampa, and has brought Harklinikken even further, closer to solving many of the most complex hair loss problems that women and men face today.

How did you come up with the idea of a specialized hair restoration facilities?

Back in 1989 there were very few treatments available for hair loss: I discovered through studies and interviews with hundreds of men and women suffering from hair loss that this problem was massive. There was not much material available on the subject and the different categories of hair loss were not yet very well described in the literature. Since then I made it my aim to help people with hair loss problems. I opened my first clinic in 1992 in Copenhagen and I have never looked back.

Given the fact that you are a scientist, how much are you involved in the research and development of the treatment?

I am head of R&D and involved in all the details of our research on a daily basis.

What are the major causes of hair loss nowadays? Is it lifestyle or simply just genetical?

It really depends on each and every person, but elements of both factors come into play. The most common cause of hair loss is a hereditary condition called male or female -pattern baldness, also known as androgenetic hair loss. In genetically susceptible people, certain sex hormones trigger a particular pattern of hair loss, and this type of hair loss seems more prominent in the UAE/GCC. Certain conditions may aggravate this type of hair loss, like the fact that a large percentage of women and men are covered.

Desalinated drinking water, tap water used for showering with high chlorine content, lack of essential nutrients, not enough sleep. severe heat and humidity, and constant exposure to A/C are some of the factors that may also contribute to the hair loss.

Do you believe in the idea that 'prevention is better than cure', especially when it comes to hair loss? Hair loss under the physiological category can be triggered by lifestyle and can to some degree be avoided if the necessary changes are made. Often we see patients where the hair loss problem is triggered by stress, perhaps because of too much work, bad sleep or poor nutrition or a combination of several things but when they become aware of the negative influence these elements have on the hair, it can urge them to act and reverse the negative cycle.

A greater part of the people living in Gulf region could improve their hair to some degree with certain lifestyle changes - which



Does geography or the environment play a role in hair loss?

Yes indeed, as I mentioned before there are various elements that can contribute, with levels of stress being the most prominent. It is important to note as well that there are many more issues to take into consideration with women's hair loss as compared to men's hair loss, as women have more hormonal aspects to take into consideration such as pregnancies, breastfeeding-hair loss. Women also treat and damage their hair more than men do with hair straighteners, hair colour, blow-drying, styling products etc., but in general, it is important to understand that we customise all our treatments for women and men, so in our view each client is a unique case.

The earlier we start treating a hair loss problem the more results the client gets and a better chance to completely reverse the problem and maintain good hair.

What advice would you give to our readers suffering from some type of

differs from individual to individual. Living in the UAE climate can be tough on the hair; here are a few effective hair care tips:

Stress Less : Plan well so you stress less! Stress is literally one of the biggest killers as it often leads to other bad things like bad eating habits because you don't have time to cook or eat well and often people who smoke, drink coffee and/or alcohol will do this more when stressed out and sleeping patterns are also disturbed. Lack of nutrients and increased levels of stress hormones such as cortisol can severely increase hair loss. One of the best ways to reduce stress is first to acknowledge that there is a problem and secondly to identify where. Often, a greater part of being stressed can be overcome by being very organised and planning well.

- Natural & Balanced Food: Eat unprocessed food containing right amounts of protein, carbohydrates, fatty acids and water, as imbalances can cause disturbance in all body mechanisms, so make sure that you have good variation in your food intake as lack of certain nutrients can cause problems with the hair.

- Diet Control: If you are thinking of losing weight or if you are already on a diet - make sure you are not losing too much weight in a short period, as this leads to big hormonal changes in your system that may result in hair loss. Crash diets are unhealthy. Go for a healthy diet over a longer period and the weight loss will be more stable and so will your hormonal system. Seek professional advice if you do not know how to balance this yourself.

Choosing a Shampoo: Wash your hair often with shampoo that doesn't contain perfume, colour and preservatives. It has been said that it is not good to wash your

• hair too often as it strips the hair and scalp of its natural oils, but when washing with the correct shampoo, it is not a problem to wash daily or every other day. At Harklinikken we advise clients in how often they should wash and with what, and also how to take care of their hair and scalp in general.

- Tight buns: Do not put your hair up too tight – make sure it is slightly loose. Hair loss from pulling causes scarring in the hair follicles and may result in permanent hair loss

- Selecting Hair Dyes: When colouring hair, try to keep it to the hair and not on the scalp. Several dyes contain chemicals that are not suitable for contact with skin and scalp, like Para-phenylendiamine (PPD) and many others. If you get a severe allergic reaction it can result in eczema and severe hair loss. The same applies to styling products - make sure you apply them carefully to the hair and avoid contact with scalp to avoid contact allergies, eczema and potential harmful effects.

- Deeper Sleep: Try not to drink coffee after 4 pm to ensure deeper sleep • resulting in better hormone balance, better



metabolism, more energy and this way more optimal circumstances for healthy

- Exercise: Exercise minimum three times a week since this increases general health and hormone balance, which optimizes hair health as well. Try to exercise no more than 30 min., as this seems optimal for body balance.

- Water, sunlight and heat from the weather: Dryers and flattening irons can certainly play a role in the hair's appearance. The hair shaft is made up of dead, hard protein called keratin in three layers. The outer layer is the cuticle formed by tightly packed scales in an overlapping structure similar to roof shingles. Bad water quality, sun and heat affect the cuticle and make the hair look more damaged. There are pigment cells distributed throughout the hairs' inner layers (cortex and medulla) giving the hair its characteristic colour. The pigment cells are altered by sun light and water high in chlorine causing bleaching and breakage of the hair. Try to cover the hair from sunlight and if you use a blow dryer – do it as little as possible as it is not only the heat but also the electrical output from the blow dryer that damages the hair.

- Hair Extensions & Scarring: Hair

extensions can cause serious permanent damage to hair. Some types of hair extensions cause less damage than others. Avoid hair extensions that are woven/ braided into your existing hair and avoid the ones that can be clipped with a curved metal clip that you have to bend when you attach it to your existing hair as both types cause permanent scars in the areas where they are attached after a period of time - and no hair will grow again in such scars.

- Light Absorption: The darker your hair is the more light it absorbs. While, blond or white hair is at the opposite end of the scale. Black or dark brown hairs' ability to absorb light results in a relatively larger portion of the light energy transferred to the hair, which causes the molecules to vibrate faster. This in turn means that temperature rises, as heat is really the result of movement in the smallest particles. The conclusion is that dark hair, even though it is stronger than blond hair types, it is more prone to damage due to sun exposure, easily drying out so it should be protected with a scarf or a hat.

- Fungal Infections: Make sure that your hair is completely dry before tying it up to avoid scalp problems like fungal infections, which can also influence hair quality in a negative way.

Tell us about your product line?

The cornerstone of the Hårklinikken product treatment is a special customised liquid called an 'Extract'. The components in the customised extracts are mainly plantbased but they may also contain specific combinations of food source ingredients such as plant proteins and unique complexes of amino acids, minerals and fatty acids.

We also offer a unique range of specialised shampoos, conditioners, hair hydrators and styling products, which support the effect of the extracts. Exchanging ordinary hair care and styling products for the Harklinikken products is sometimes sufficient to treat a hair loss problem. All products are of the highest quality and are free from perfume, colour, silicone, petrochemicals and problematic preservatives.

Clearly visible results are seen after 3-4 months treatment and documented by photos.

We currently have many new products under development, one of which is called Hair Hydrating Mask. It is a unique mask that rehydrates hair without the use of silicone that merely leaves a layer on the hair. The Harklinikken mask opens the hair shaft and transports moisture into the hair. The product is ideal for those who wish to hydrate and protect their hair, without the use of perfume, colour, silicone, petrochemicals and problematic preservatives.

How do you find the market in Dubai?

We have a very large number of clients at our clinic in Dubai. Through word of mouth, awareness of Harklinikken products and services spread fast, after we opened in 2012 and clients started to see results from the treatment. We have seen over 10,000 clients in Dubai to date.

Dubai is a modern day melting pot of different cultures and nationalities where many appreciate quality and uncompromising levels of service, which we, at Harklinikken have as our core value. 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

the ABC of skin

significant marker reflecting your health and the daily stresses endured, whether personal or professional, is your skin. They emerge in the form of the dreaded red beacons pimpling the forehead or the itchy acne that can't be scratched. The triggers may be the heat and dust in the environment or the internal heat built up inside the body. In either case, the skin requires considerable care. The ABC of skin care starts with the knowledge of your skin, its functions and knowing your skin type and texture. Dr. Nathalie Domloj, Dermatologist and Brand Expert for Fair & Lovely Arabia shares with us the expert advice much needed for the current hot and humid weather...

The skin is the largest organ of the body, 2 to 3 mm thick. It has three layers; the epidermis, dermis and hypodermis. Each layer has a specific function.

• The **epidermis** is the outer-most layer that acts as a protective barrier against UV radiation, harsh weather, microorganisms as well as water loss.

• The **dermis** is the middle layer, made up of fibroblasts that produce collagen and elastin giving the skin its form, shape and elasticity.

• The **hypodermis** is the bottom or deepest layer of the skin which is made up of fat cells and fatty tissue that protects the body from mechanical trauma.

The first step in taking care of your skin is to actually know about your skin type which depends on its tone, moisture, and degree of sun exposure.

Melanin is the pigment that defines your skin tone. It is the body's natural defense mechanism against the sun UV rays. Thus the higher the melanin, the darker the skin color. Based on color, we have 5 skin types ranging from Skin Type 1, which is very fair skin to Skin Type 5, which is a very dark skin tone.

People with Skin Type 1 always burn but rarely tan when exposed to sun whereas those with Skin Type 5 lie in the other extreme - when exposed to sun, they always tan but rarely burn. Skin types 2, 3 and 4 show varying degrees of burns and tans. According to the **texture**, you can be classified as having a sensitive, environmentally-damaged, problematic (acne prone), or hyper pigmented skin that shows areas of dark patchy color. A lot of factors influence your skin texture, as well as skin tone, including genetic make-up, hormonal changes, and environmental factors like UV radiation, weather

conditions or certain medications as well as diseases.

The ABC of skin care starts with the knowledge of your skin, its functions and knowing your skin type and texture.

So, how should we take care of our skin? There are basic steps that you can take care of keeping in mind your skin tone and type. • **Cleanse** – Cleansers remove makeup, dirt and oil from your skin, hydrating and revitalizing your skin. Depending on your



skin type, there are 4 types of cleansers - gel for oily skin, lotion for normal skin, foam for men, creams for dry skin and soap-less cleanser for sensitive skin.

• **Tone** – Toners remove all impurities from your skin and shrinks your pores thus preventing pimples. It refreshes and prepares the skin for moisturizing. People with acne prone skin need a toner the most.

• Moisturize – Moisturizers hydrate your skin making your skin soft and supple, preventing wrinkles. They stimulate new cells giving you that healthy complexion. It is recommended to use rich creams for the night and light cream or lotions for the day. Regardless of your skin type, everyone needs to moisturize.

• SPF - An ideal sunscreen provides broad spectrum UVA and UVB coverage. Choose a product according to your skin type with SPF such as an advanced multi vitamin cream with SPF 15 and apply generously. Cleanse, tone, moisturize and guard your skin against exposure to ensure that you always look beautiful.

A BALANCED LIFE IS A BETTER LIFE At Work And At Home, Success Depends On Finding Equilibrium...

Life sometimes can seem off kilter as responsibilities mount and people plow all their physical and mental resources into what seems to be the most pressing crisis of the moment. Veteran Software Engineer Lumbie Mlambo, editor of Equanimity Magazine and a stroke survivor, says that it actually is a good time to take a step back. The Zimbabwean-born entrepreneur bucked the odds to create a renowned publication dedicated to regular people's stories of success and hope, she believes that everyone has the potential to shine in life's darkest moments, but the key to achieving goals and an overall better existence is to maintain a balance so that one aspect of your life isn't consumed by another. While some people might say balance in life

is an impossible goal, she disagrees and says when each of us find our equilibrium, we become more productive and a greater asset to our communities.

'There's balance in everything we do, be it walking, talking, eating, sleeping, working or spending time with family," says Mlambo. "For example, look at how we try to deal with our work-life situation. We balance our workload so that we can still make room for other activities, to spend more time with our spouses or our children. We do that because we understand how

important it is."

Reasons for why living a balanced life is essential..

- The health factor. Staying balanced is
- key to a healthier and successful life. Both mental health and physical health benefit,
- and as a result, so do our overall lives.
- When we're healthy, we're able to care for
- ourselves and others in our community,"
- : Mlambo says.

• The empathy factor. When we find balance in life, we can better understand the importance of helping the underprivileged, says Mlambo, who grew up in a rural area in Zimbabwe. You begin to realize that someday you could be in their situation, which makes you a more empathetic person. "Your economic situation is like your health," she says. "Nothing is guaranteed."

• The role-model factor. Sharing our stories - whether it's a tale of success or even a tale of failure – is important because others can learn from us or be inspired by us as they too strive for a balanced life. "When you tell your story, it empowers, motivates and encourages people to not give up on their dreams and goals," Mlambo says. "Maybe you think your story is just not that interesting or important. But for someone out there, it may be the spark that ignites them to great things."

Mlambo always strove to find balance in her life. But she became even more passionate about it after she suffered a stroke in 2001 that left her partially paralyzed. She since has recovered, but says the event had a profound impact on her and she will always consider herself a stroke patient. "Before the stroke, I thought my life was balanced in a way," she says. "I mean, I ate healthy foods. I exercised seven days a week. But it was not balanced in the way I wanted. I had been too focused on myself. I realized that life was not just about me, but about others."

Finding balance in life isn't just a feel-good concept, Mlambo says. As people achieve balance, they realize they have the potential to rise above their circumstances. They can become more productive in their



communities and that is good for everyone. "Staying proactive and shifting the way we think can even help the economy to grow and can help create more jobs," she says. Certainly, maintaining a balanced life may be tougher than ever because technology allows work - emails, text messages, telephone calls - to intrude on people's "off" hours. But that's just all the more reason to make a concerted effort to strive for balance, Mlambo says.

She says it's become popular in some circles to argue that a balanced life is a myth and can't be achieved. But regardless of their views, she says, most people seem to be trying to bring balance to their lives, even if they don't think of it that way.

"We eat healthy to stay balanced, we get enough sleep or rest to avoid stress, we juggle our daily activities to stay balanced," Mlambo says. "To be successful in anything : we do, we must have some sort of balance.'

: THAILAND - BANGKOK



Method

Preheat oven to 220°C. Place the lamb in a large baking dish. Use a sharp knife to make 10 x 4cm incisions into the lamb.

Juice 1 lemon half. Combine with 1 tablespoon oil, garlic, salt and pepper. Cut remaining lemon into 10 small pieces. Push lemon pieces into incisions. Brush lamb with oil mixture and roast for 15 minutes.

In the remaining oil, toss potatoes, oregano, salt and pepper. Arrange potatoes around lamb. Return to oven and roast for 40 minutes.

Add carrots to roasting pan with lamb and potatoes. Roast a further 20 minutes. Remove lamb from oven. Increase oven temperature to 230°C.

Cook potatoes and carrots a further 15 minutes or until crisp. Cover lamb loosely with foil and rest for 15 minutes. Carve lamb, serve with potatoes and carrots. Courtesy: www.taste.com.au

Use a slotted spoon to transfer meat to a plate. Place dish over high heat (if you are using a tagine you will need to transfer the liquid to a frying pan).
