



Starring opposite, Kristen Stewart in

Blake Lively shook Cannes and took it by
storm as she appeared on the red carpet.
Another one of her movies, The Shallows,

a horror picture not far from Jaws, is soon to open in French theatres. The beautiful star and brand ambassador of Gucci as well as L'Oréal, attended the Paris Premiere alongside director Jaume Collet-Serra, We met Blake at a hotel in Paris and talked about her characters in her latest movies, family life and working with Woody Allen.



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You are very pregnant, so when is the baby due?

Very soon now, that is the reason why I'm touring Europe very briefly in order to promote Shallows, and I shall be flying back to the States in a few days' time.

You star in Woody Allen's Café Society alongside Kristen Stewart. So did you two get along well on the set?

Kristen and I did not have many scenes together, but we used to meet in the studio and on the various locations where the picture was shot, and yes we did get along quite well. I remember us laughing out loud a lot and getting remarks about that from Woody Allen who enjoyed behaving like a teacher or a school master. But none of that ever affected our work and Mr. Allen truly worried about nothing at all.

Did you two become friends and still see each other?

We became friends, but me being pregnant and working on Shallows, and her being busy working on a new project as well, we do not get time to really see each other. But we keep in touch. It's quite easy to do so nowadays with all the modern technology. Your second movie, Shallows is a horror film. Did you enjoy working in a horror movie?

Yes I did, and one of my favorite one remains Jaws by Steven Spielberg. So when I learned I had to play in a somehow similar film, with a shark trying to eat me, I felt like a little girl whose dream has come true. I am very happy to be in Shallows, especially as I believe it is a very good movie, and I am almost all alone in it from beginning to end. What can an actress ask for more than that? You were pregnant while shooting Shallows?

Yes, at least at the very end of it.

You spend the entire film in water with a shark. Was that ok for you?

The shark was not real, and water never harmed a pregnant woman. So I guess everything was fine.

You looked stunning at Cannes

Festival. What memories do you keep of that moment on the red carpet surrounded by dozens of photographers shouting your name just to get a look or a smile from you towards their cameras?

Thank you for the compliment, and I must admit I felt like a goddess! I have never attended a ceremony where people seem to be crazy about cinema like in the Cannes Festival. They truly love films and movie stars. Any actor would be flattered to be there, but I couldn't bear it for more than two days, on the run. Otherwise I'd go crazy myself. Believe me it's odd to go back to a normal life after living the Cannes experience.

Television made you famous through the series Gossip Girl. Would you work for TV now, or do you consider yourself a movie star and nothing else?

I remain in debt towards television for my celebrity status, and since cinema took over

face to face

I haven't had the time or the opportunity to be in a TV series again. Now if I get such an offer in the future, and if I like the story as well as the characters, mainly the one I shall have to portray, then yes I'll take it at once. There is no such thing for me as movie star or television star or stage star, I'm an actress and I do my job whether it belongs to one or the other of the artistic disciplines that exist. I'm just waiting for the right role in the right series.

You have been appointed Ambassador for Gucci Premiere fragrance, and also for L'Oreal. How does that feel, and in what way is it an actresses' job to promote beauty products?

Well, to answer the first part of your question, it feels great. Why? Simply because I am very much fond in my everyday life of elegance, fashion, beauty products and perfumes. So, if I get lucky enough to be chosen in order to represent a brand that deals with one or more of the things I have mentioned, I would be crazy to say no. Now as for the second part of the question, an actresses' image is often associated with glamour, and that is why the brands choose actresses to represent their beauty products. They also do that with famous super models of course. So for me there is nothing at all shocking in the process, as long as I am truly convinced with the product I represent. I would never agree to become Ambassador for a kitchen brand for instance.

You are already the mother of a little girl, so do you believe you will still find enough time for acting when you'll have your second child, which is very soon now?

Yes absolutely, as I believe it's all a matter of organization, and Ryan (Reynolds) and I, are organized persons, and we intend to have many children without ever quitting our artistic activities. We believe, both in our work and in large families.



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TALKING

With Joy Ajlouny, Co-founder Fetchr

ith over 20 years in the e-commerce industry, Joy Ajlouny is a professional whose business and fashion influence has spanned the globe. Joy is the co-founder of Fetchr, a company based in Dubai providing online shipping services in emerging markets and it is backed by investors, venture capitalists from the incredible Silicon Valley. Fetchr is the first start-up in the Middle East to be funded by a top venture capital firm in Silicon Valley.

Prior to Fetchr, Joy had founded Bonfaire, an internet-based, discovery platform for luxury footwear and accessories, which was also backed by venture capital. Bonfaire was acquired in 2013 by fashion e-commerce giant Mode Operandi, owned by LVMH (Moët Hennessy Louis Vuitton SE) and Condé Nast. In a world where only a few women have secured venture capital for their emerging businesses or start-ups, statistics say only 2.7% of venture capital funds have been raised by women, Joy has successfully raised funds for two companies from some of the most prestigious Silicon Valley venture capital firms.

A strategic advisor to fashion startups, venture capital firms and major fashion publications, we talked to Joy about her multimillion dollar business, her challenges as an entrepreneur and a woman of the world.



Tell us about yourself? How did you come up with the idea of Fetchr?

Before coming to Dubai and co-founding Fetchr, I started a fashion e-commerce startup called Bonfaire in San Francisco. The website featured new and undiscovered designers, allowing them access to massmarkets. Part of my marketing strategy was to reach the Middle Eastern market as I knew it was filled with highly fashion driven women looking for undiscovered brands, and I also believed it would be highly profitable. My strategy paid off as we successfully marketed to the Middle East, and started to get an unbelievable number

But frustratingly, most of my shipments would be returned to the USA with a note saying could not find the address, return to sender. Of course, I thought there must be some mistake on the delivery company's part. But upon further investigation, I came to discover that the problem was that there were no addresses in the Middle East. Coming from the USA, this baffled me! So I started to look into how businesses are able to deliver packages. The answer surprised me-it happened through a series of annoying calls asking for directions through landmarks. As a company offering exclusive products from curated designers, I hated that this was part of our customers' experience with our brand.

I knew there had to be a better way. I wanted to solve this problem, especially being an Arab myself (I am originally Palestinian). And thus, Fetchr was born. Fetchr is an app that allows you to use your cell phone number as your address and therefore delivers packages to your phone. We have a patent for using a smartphone's GPS location as an address. No more annoying phone calls with language barriers asking where you live, and for landmarks and directions. Similar to Uber, a simple tap tells our drivers exactly where you are, and you can track your package coming to you, and no waiting around-we work around your schedule, which is how it should be. We want to make shipping as much fun as shopping.

As a woman what are the major challenges you faced?

Queen Rania had a quote that I loved, saying: "We have to break the molds that shape women and girls from the moment they are born. We must break the molds women are born into; molds that have been passed on through generations, undermining women's talent and ambition. This really sums up what must be done. Mothers must teach their girls that they can accomplish anything they set their minds to. There are no limits, they can achieve greatness, that there must be more to accomplish in life than looking pretty and marrying the right man. Arab women are smart, and we should show the world what we can accomplish. I do believe that this must be embedded in mothers first to teach the next generation that is where it must start to break the pattern that has existed for generations.



You raised \$11 Million for Fetchr? How did you manage the task?

In the world of venture capital, only 2% of all funding goes to women founders, but as a female founder, I raised millions of dollars for my company and later, in Dubai, I helped Fetchr raise our \$11 million Series A funding. Basically my strategy is: don't take no for an answer! If they don't want to take a meeting, request a coffee, find out what events they're going to and speak to them after, find mutual friends on Facebook and LinkedIn and ask for introductions, find their office number and call them, or find their office address and show up! There's always a way—and persistence pays off.

How do you balance your career with your family life being an entrepreneur?

Easy—I find work that I love, and I have a team that I love! My work is my passion, my colleagues are my close friends, and I'm always doing what I love.

What is your major inspiration in life?

That's easy that would be my mom. My mom is a Palestinian refugee, who has not only supported me when it came to following my dreams but encouraged me. She always pushed me to reach my potential, telling me "Joy, if you can dream it you can accomplish it." She told me it's okay to fail, because failure is part of what makes you stronger. What are your future plans? Three letters: IPO.


Do you have any word of advice for our readers especially women who are striving to make a career change or start up a business?

How do you find Dubai?

I like it very much, Dubai is very faithful and everybody has to experience Dubai at least once. I like the desert of Dubai, I discovered it many years ago. If you are asking in terms of nature then I like Oman. But energy wise, I like Dubai because we meet different nationalities and I like the fact as well that it is not too far from France as well and I can travel easily, it is a 6 hours iourney.

You yourself represent cultural diversity, with Middle Eastern roots and European brought up. What do you think is needed to bridge the cultures together?

We need to listen to people and focus on them first, what their need is, concern is, and question is. Sometimes even though you do not like something but you need to simply be more tolerant. Working in the beauty industry, what are your thoughts on beauty, how would you define it?

ut of all the lessons taught in life, from the time when we were young to the ones we learn today, the ones that still resonate in our memory are; to be good, to think positive and to take our vitamins regularly... 
For the sweet touch, we tried the carrot cake, which was more of a piece of art than cake! Carefully placed on a rectangular dish,

The deluxe room (which definitely was 'A room with a view') had a picturesque and an uninterrupted view of Burj Khalifa,

Upon entering the restaurant from within the hotel (it also has direct access to Mohammed Bin Rashid Boulevard), I couldn't help notice the huge metallic geometric screens covering the wall, small and large 'Dallah' (coffee pots), wooden panels and archways leading to the courtyard, high ceiling, tall hanging curtains flowing casually, was a spot on reminiscence from the Arabian nights... After finding a comfortable place to sit, we were eager to try the much talked about food which is freshly prepared in an open plan kitchen. In a mood to try the various tastes from different regions Boulevard Kitchen promises to offer, we ordered a variety. First off Lentil & Harrira soup! An absolutely delicious Lentil soup

· where nothing was too much or too little, the right amount of creaminess and grainy texture with exact spice level. The Harrira soup was also a hit with its mellow taste and texture. For the mains, we ordered Mix grill and Jumbo Prawns along with Butter Chicken. The mix grill came packed with a variety of protein (chicken, lamb and beef) and was cooked to perfection on the Josper oven, which helped retain the real juice of the meat, keeping it tender and moist. The Jumbo Prawns came with a feisty presentation; three whole jumbo prawns stacked artfully, rubbed with butter glaze, parsley, a hint of sumac, and no adjectives for us to spell out the pleasure ... It delighted us through and through...

The butter chicken had its own story. We were thinking a common run of the mill butter chicken, and honestly although every other restaurant features a succulent butter chicken on the menu but until experiencing it at the Boulevard Kitchen, I had always been totally disappointed. Only this time it tasted exactly how it should be, mildly spicy with a buttery curry sauce. Paired with freshly boiled white rice, it was succulent and delicious and felt like a comfortable and filling, home cooked meal that nothing can replace...

For the final sweet touch, we had just enough room for "Umm Ali".... The decadent, warm dessert is an Arabic essential. We were blown away by the simple yet immensely gratifying

Breakfast at The Courtyard


After a peaceful night, we woke up ready for our next foray into the world of possibilities at Manzil, with breakfast at The Courtyard. Located in the center of the hotel, the

Method

In a small bowl mix water and yeast to dissolve. Set the bowl aside for 10 minutes for yeast to start to bubble

You can mix the dough by hand or by dough mixer with dough handle attachment. If using a big bowl put the flour in and make a well in

Pour water, yeast, and olive oil into the well. Knead the dough till it starts to come together and not stick to the sides of the bowl. Remove the dough from the bowl and knead on a floured work surface.

Knead the dough till it becomes smooth and elastic. Clean the big bowl, dry and rub with a little oil. Place the dough back into the bowl and cover with a cloth or plastic wrap.

Place the dough in a warm place and let it rise until it doubles in size, (30 - 45 minutes.)


Cut the dough into 8-12 equal sizes. Roll into balls and set aside for 10 minutes to rest.

Roll out the dough, and spread meat on top of the dough.

Preheat oven to 250C. Put the Lahm Bajeen on a tray and put it in the oven. Cooking times will vary, so keep an eye (6 - 10 minutes) till sides start to have a nice brown color.

Garnish with lemon wedges, fresh zatar, pomegranate molasses, sliced tomatoes, cucumber, mint leaves & serve.




