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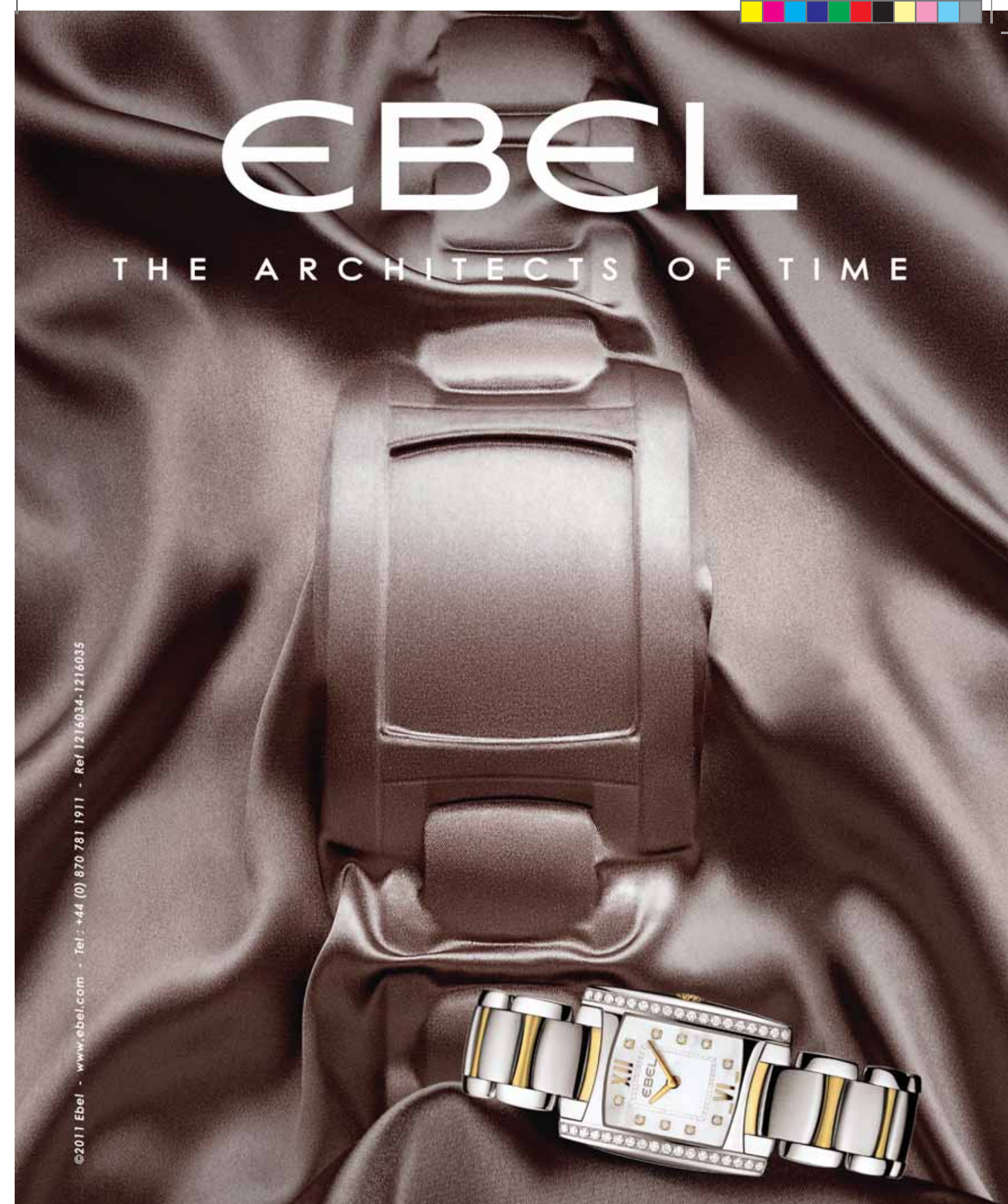
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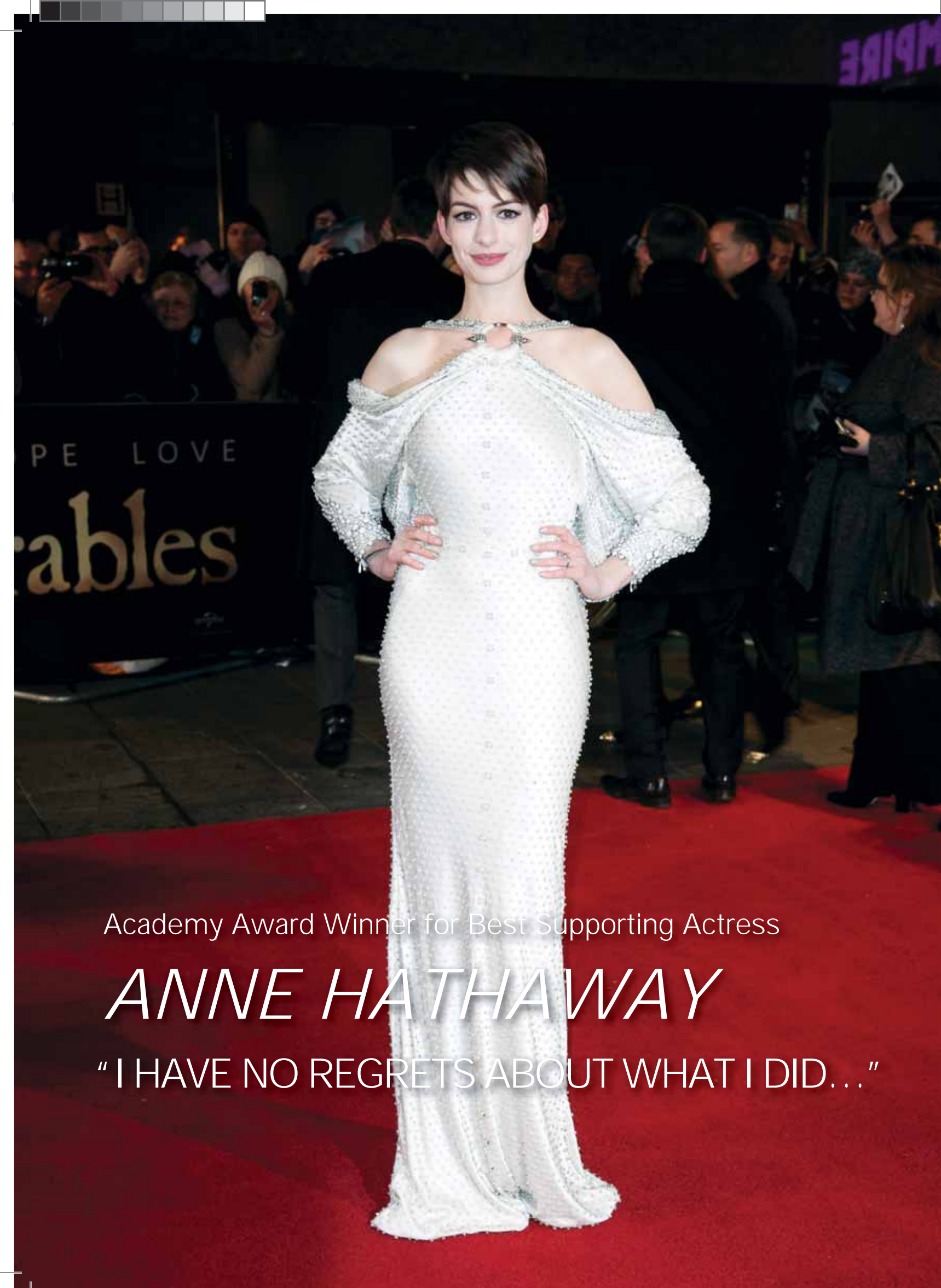


  
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Academy Award Winner for Best Supporting Actress

**ANNE HATHAWAY**

"I HAVE NO REGRETS ABOUT WHAT I DID..."

*She started out performing in plays while in High School and won the Paper Mill Playhouse Rising Star Award nomination for best performance by a High School Actress, where she sang the song 'Shy' by Princess Winnifred in the musical, Once Upon a Dream. In 2012, the Soprano sang the haunting notes of, I dreamed a dream, for Les Misérables and won the Oscar!*

The glamorous *Anne Hathaway* has won the Oscar for Best Supporting Actress for her role in Tom Hooper's musical film *Les Misérables* in which she co-starred with *Hugh Jackman, Russell Crowe and Amanda Seyfried*. The film is the screen adaptation of the long running stage musical that had been created in the early eighties in London and Broadway by *Alain Boublil* and

*Claude-Michel Schönberg*, before being shown worldwide. On the occasion of the Paris launch of the cinematographic version of *Les Misérables*, a few days only before flying to Los Angeles to attend the Oscar ceremony, *Anne Hathaway* met with "First Avenue" in an exclusive encounter held in one of the Capital's most prestigious hotels: The Bristol.

**FIRST AVENUE:** *How does it feel being nominated for the Oscar in the Best Supporting Actress category?*

**ANNE HATHAWAY:** It feels very, very good actually. I hope I'll make it.

**F.A:** *What if you don't?*

**A.H:** Then I shall say that whoever got it deserved it, which will be the truth anyway.

**F.A:** *Had you seen the play Les Misérables before getting involved in the film project?*

**A.H:** I saw it as a kid in New York. I must have been ten years old at the time, and the play had already been

running for about a decade. I never imagined playing the part of Fantine or singing that wonderful song that I Dreamed a Dream is.

**F.A:** *Since you bring up singing, and since you performed by yourself in Les Misérables, how long did it take you to prepare for the part of Fantine?*

**A.H:** I spent six months rehearsing the singing under the supervision of a coach. I had sung before on stage but never in a musical, and I must tell you that the songs in Les Misérables were shot directly like any other normal scene in the film, which is very unusual in musicals as the songs are always recorded

afterwards in the studios. It was difficult but it brings a reality to the film that was quite unseen before.

**F.A:** *You lost weight for the part of Fantine as you look really skinny on screen. Was it hard to achieve?*

**A.H:** I lost about 24 pounds for the part of Fantine and yes it was hard to achieve as I had to stop eating. And I am a person who normally loves to eat. But I have my priorities, and to be fit for that part was one of them. So I have no regrets about what I did or how I did it especially that it was me who asked the director to allow me to lose weight and not the other way round. Now I am racing for the Oscar!

**F.A:** *Shall we go further back into your career and talk about the remarkable film Love and other Drugs, one of your best performances, in which you costar with Jake Gyllenhaal, and where you play a young woman suffering from Parkinson's disease. Have you done any research on this disease before the shooting?*

**A.H:** Not really since the director Edward Zwick had considered the matter very thoroughly and had very much decorated, if I may say so, the script, already with written notes on the margins regarding Parkinson's disease and its various symptoms. I just had to read carefully these annotations and build my character starting from that point. But not only

from that, since each patient has his own life and reacts emotionally to the illness in his own way. So I created some sort of mixture between what generally happens and the events that shook my character's personal life in the story.

**F.A:** *But have you ever met people with this disease while you were preparing for the part?*

**A.H:** No. I have a friend who has a friend who in turn is affected. But I've never had the opportunity to meet this person or anyone else suffering from Parkinson's disease.

**F.A:** *The film contains many explicit love scenes between your lover played by Jake Gyllenhaal and yourself. What was the need in your opinion, for including such scenes in the dramatic context of the film?*

**A.H:** These scenes are in my opinion, since you ask for it, essential to the film. They show how people, especially the young women in

particular, approach their love life through their illness. A woman with a serious illness can continue to have a love life and a partner as long as they both learn to deal with that particular situation. The success of the love life in a case like this, depends heavily on the partner. We all wanted, the director, Jake (Gyllenhaal) and myself, to approach my character's daily life from all angles, including love.

**F.A:** *How did the shooting of these particular scenes go with Jake Gyllenhaal?*

**A.H:** We got to know each other during rehearsals, but it took us both the courage to dive into the sheets together in front of the camera and all the technicians and look as if we were two passionate lovers whereas in fact we hardly knew one another. But we fortunately quickly developed a professional closeness that has saved us all for the remaining days of the shooting. I mean that we saved time by doing things quickly and in the right way.



*F.A: Your celebrity grows gradually along with your movies. How do you live your stardom?*

*A.H:* I learn to tame it as a pet, at least for now. The animal may die and fame can come to disappear overnight. In fact, I deal with its many advantages and disadvantages. It is always easier to amplify the negative aspect of our lives and complain, or am I wrong? In any case, that is how I am and that is why I provide efforts to try and perceive only the benefits of stardom and be happy about it and about all the things that are going well for me at the present time.

*F.A: And are you happy?*

*A.H:* Reasonably. If I was too happy, I would start to feel guilty bout it!

*F.A: You always seem to chose your films and your parts with great intelligence. Is it deliberate or are these the offers that you normally get?*

*A.H:* Actually, I am a very lucky person. In fact, I get offers for all kinds of movies but my instinct guides me towards those who will eventually become major works. I think I'm good at sniffing out good deals. And that is what I call luck.



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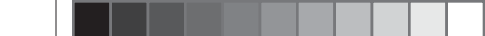

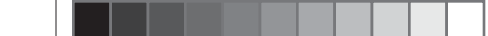


## Chanel - Spring 2013 Couture

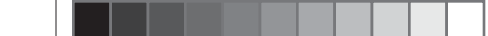


## *Versace - Spring 2013 Couture*

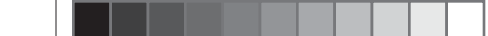


## Elie Saab - Spring / Summer 2013 Haute Couture

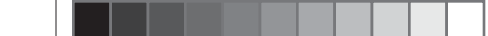


## Valentino - Spring 2013 Couture

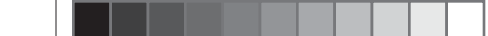


## *Zuhair Murad - Spring 2013 Haute Couture Collection*

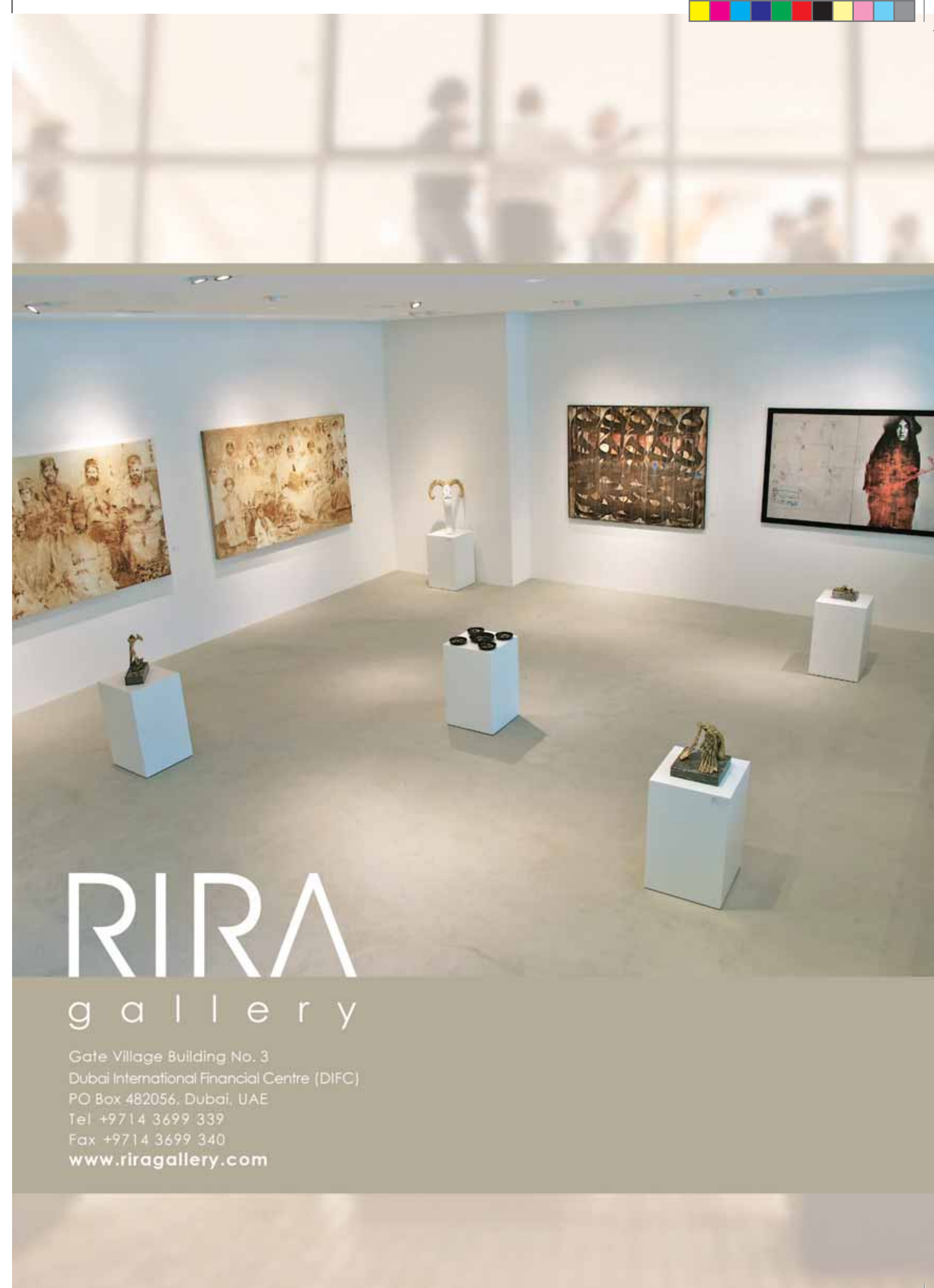




## Spring 2013 Trends

Ingredients for 4

- 1kg U-10 Tiger Prawns (ready peeled)
- 300g Arborio Rice
- 1.5l Good quality shop bought fish stock
- 10g Smoked paprika
- 30g Finely chopped chives
- 100ml Extra virgin olive oil / chilli oil
- 180 Finely chopped shallots
- 200ml Emirates towers house wine - Nonalcoholic White wine (optional)
- 150g Unsalted butter
- 120g Parmesan cheese



## Method

Begin by lightly frying the finely chopped shallots without colour in a large sauce pan. Add the rice and stir in for around 2 minutes. Add the wine if using and continuously stir the rice until the wine has been absorbed.

Warm the stock in a separate pan, and begin to add to the rice bit by bit, stirring continuously.

After around ten minutes of the rice cooking, it should be ready, with a slight bite to it still, not too soft, and all the stock should have been added.

Take the prawns and chop all but four of them into one cm cubed pieces.

Add the prawns to the rice, and cook for a further 2 minutes.

To finish, add the grated pammersan, butter, paprika and chives then season to taste.

The consistency should be quite thick, without being gloopy.

Pan fry the remaining 4 prawns, then split the risotto into 4 servings, and place one of the pan fried prawns on top of each serving. Drizzle chilli oil over the risotto to finish if desired, then ready to serve.



## Welsh Lamb with Braised shoulder

Ingredients for 4

- 480g Welsh Lamb rack -- French trimmed and portion @120g keep the bones from
- The rack for the stock
- 400g Lamb shoulder -- boneless and cut in to chunks
- 60g Baby leeks -- Washed and peeled
- 60g Baby carrots -- Washed and peeled
- 60g Baby turnip -- Washed and peeled
- Salt and pepper
- Mint leaves as garnish
- Braising liquid
- 200g Onion -- peeled and roughly cut
- 150g Carrot -- peeled and roughly cut
- 150g Celery -- peeled and roughly cut
- 150g Leeks -- peeled, wash and roughly cut
- 80g Tomato paste
- 10g Bay leaves -- dried
- 10g Black pepper corn
- 5g Thyme
- 3kg Lamb bones -- roasted
- 4litre Water -- hot
- Salt to taste

## Method

### To make the braising liquor

On a deep pot, sauté onion, carrot, celery, leeks until they are soft. Add the tomato paste, bay leaves, black pepper corn and thyme. Add lamb bones, cover with water and bring to the simmer and reduce by half and strain.

In a pan seal of the lamb shoulder, remove and drain any excess fat. Place into a deep sided tray cove with the braising liquid, and cover with foil. Put in the oven for 2-3hours at moderate heat to 170°C or until it the lamb is soft top the touch. Remove the lamb and reduce the braising liquor to make the sauce.

Season the welsh lamb rack with salt and pepper, in a hot pan

with a little oil seal on both sides, Put it in oven at 190°C for 8-10 minutes for medium or a little longer if required. Remove from the oven and allow to rest for 3 minutes, then cut in to half.

Bring a pan of water to the boil, add salt and blanch the baby vegetables, remove and dry. Heat a pan and sauté the vegetable in oil until lightly colored, fish with a nob of butter and correct the seasoning

Put the shoulder on the plate and lay the lamb rack agents, garnished with the seared baby vegetables and drizzle the reduce lamb sauce, Garnished with mint leaves.





## The Ivy Eggs Arlington

### Ingredients for 4

2 English muffins  
4 organic eggs  
Smoked salmon (100g roughly)  
Malt vinegar ( large table spoon for poaching)  
Ground black pepper

#### For the Hollandaise sauce

360g clarified butter (ghee)  
20ml tarragon vinegar  
Half a juiced lemon  
4 large organic egg yolks (fresh)  
Table salt and ground white pepper

### Method

To make the Hollandaise, take a large heavy bottom sauce pan and fill with water, and bring to the boil and reduce to a simmer. In a glass mixing bowl, take the egg yolks, add the tarragon vinegar, then place the bowl over the top of the saucepan of boiling water (a bain marie) to heat gently. Whisk the egg yolks until they double in volume, until you have a fluffy egg mix, being careful not to over-cook the yolks to avoid scrambling. Remove the egg yolk mix from the heat.

Warm the clarified butter to liquid form, and then slowly add into the egg yolk, until combined. Season with salt and pepper and add lemon juice to taste. Place the hollandaise sauce in a container and store at room temperature.

Add a tablespoon of white wine vinegar to a saucepan of water and bring to the boil then reduce to a simmer. Crack



the eggs and pour each into a separate ramekin (note: add a dash of vinegar in each ramekin to help the white of the egg form around the yolk when poaching)

Gently pour the eggs into the water, one at a time, until all 4 are in the simmering water, and leave in the water for 3 minutes until cooked.

Cut the muffins in half lengthways, and toast until golden brown on both sides. Place the ham on top of the halved muffins and warm under the grill for 30 seconds.

Drain the excess water from the poached eggs on a kitchen cloth, place the muffins with the smoked salmon on the centre of a plate, and place a poached egg on top of each muffin. Finish with two tablespoons of Hollandaise sauce and a generous twist of black pepper and serve immediately.

## Scandinavian iced berries



### Ingredients for 4

1kg frozen berries (100–120 g per person)  
(strawberries, raspberries, blackberries, redcurrants, blackcurrants)

#### For the sauce

600g white chocolate buttons  
600ml double cream

### Method

Place the chocolate buttons and the cream in a bowl over a pan of simmering water for 20–30 minutes, stirring every so often. When the sauce is hot, it is ready to go.

Five minutes before serving, put the berries on to dessert plates and leave at room temperature to lose a little of their chill. Transfer the chocolate sauce into a serving jug. Place the berries in front of your guests and pour the hot chocolate sauce at the table. Insist that you cover the berries generously for the best result!

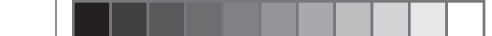

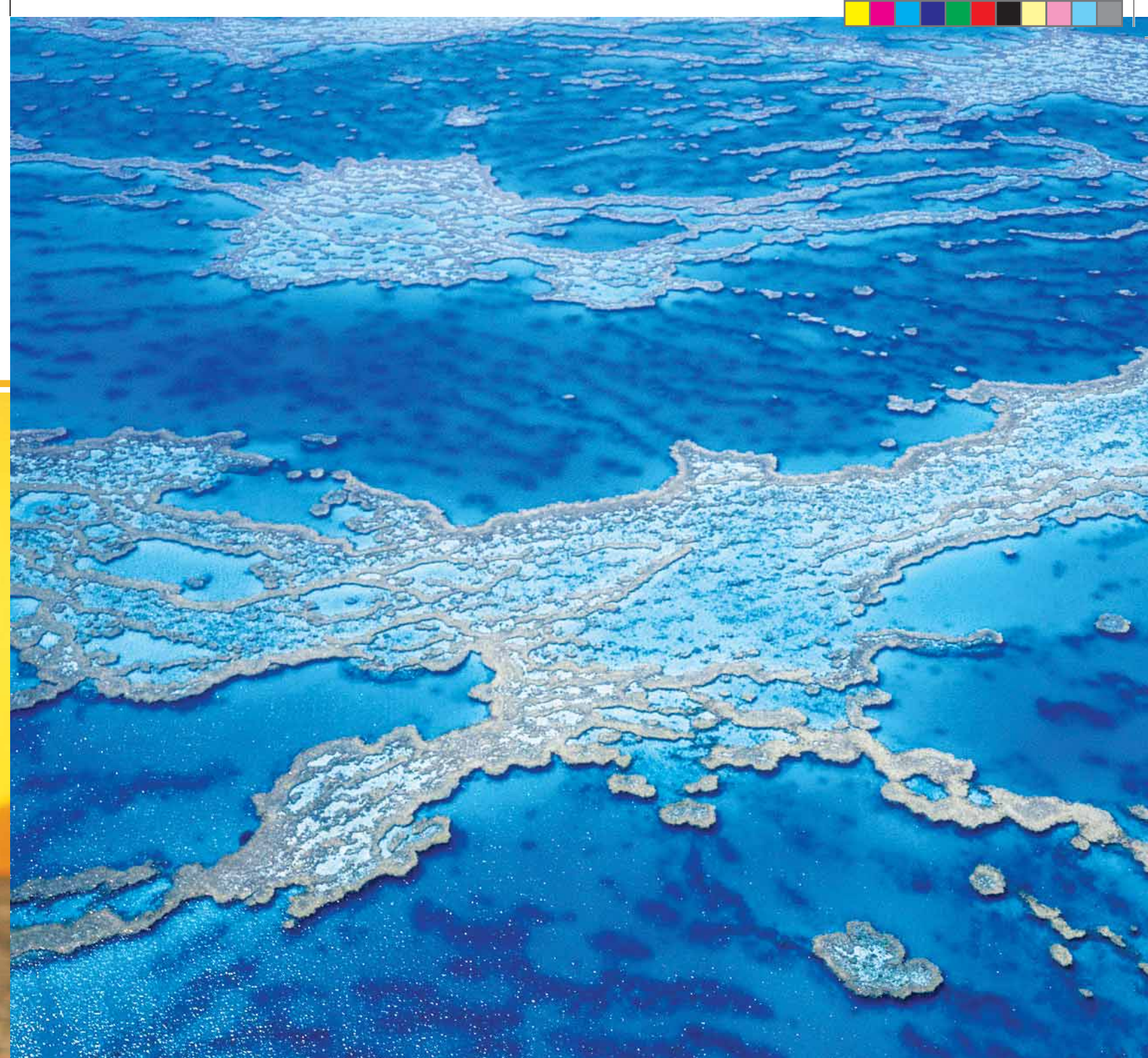

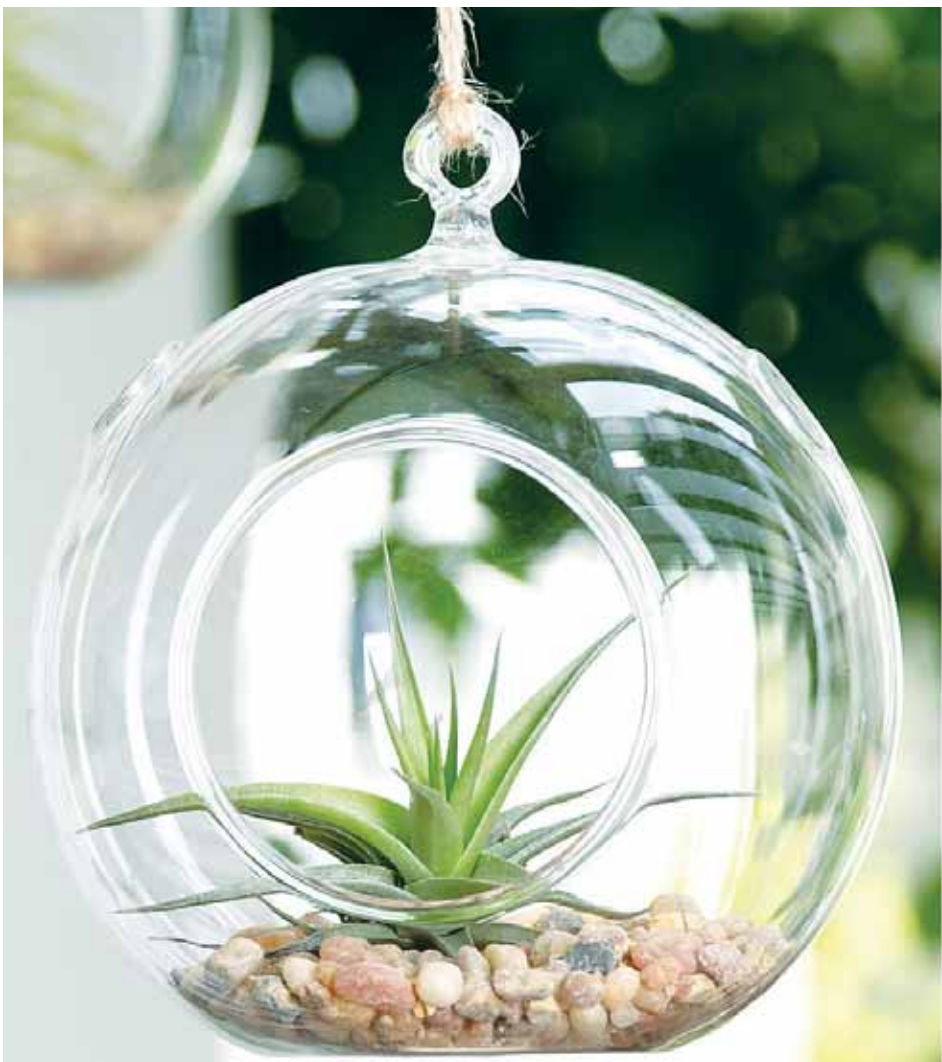
### Reorganize Bookshelves

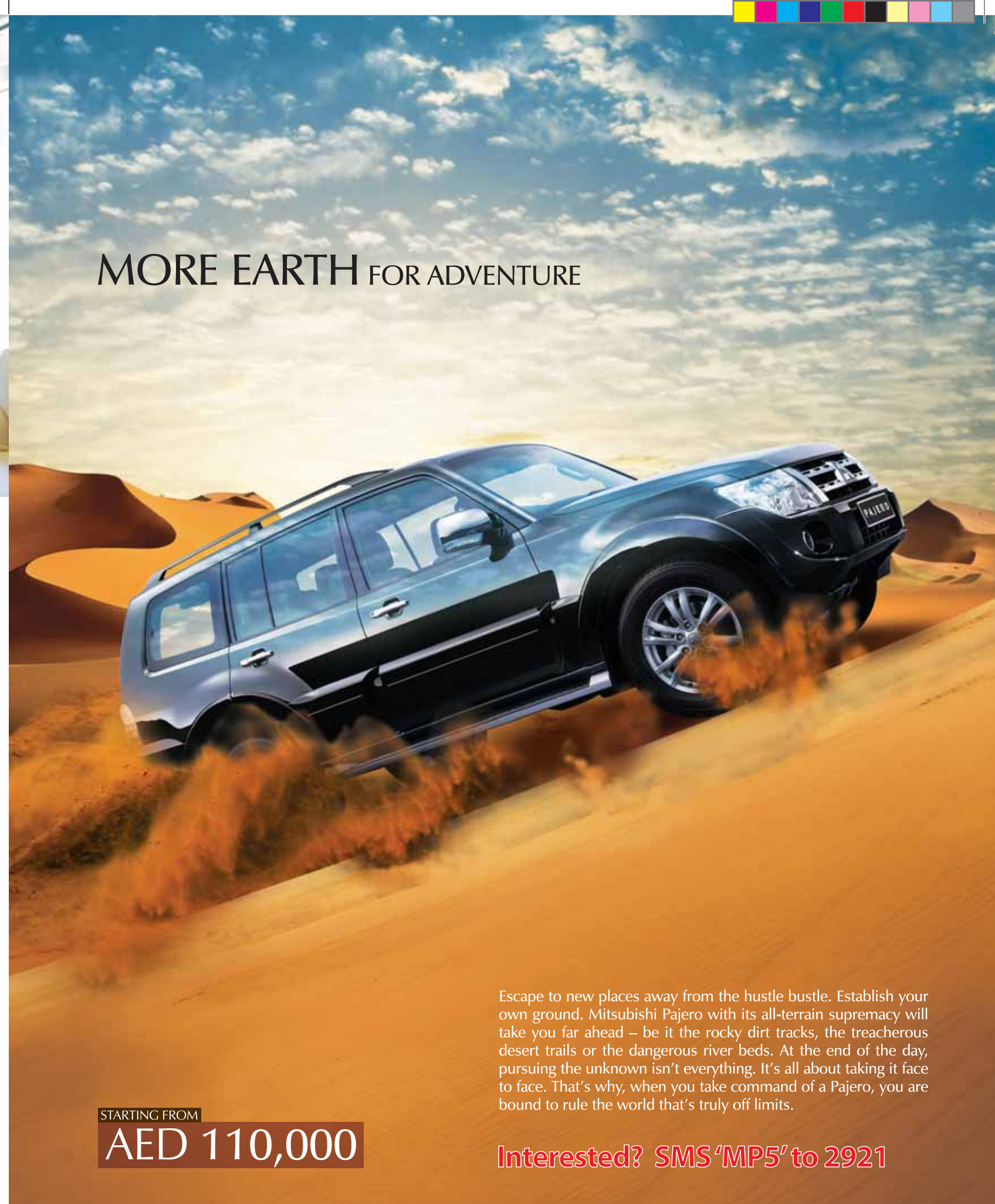

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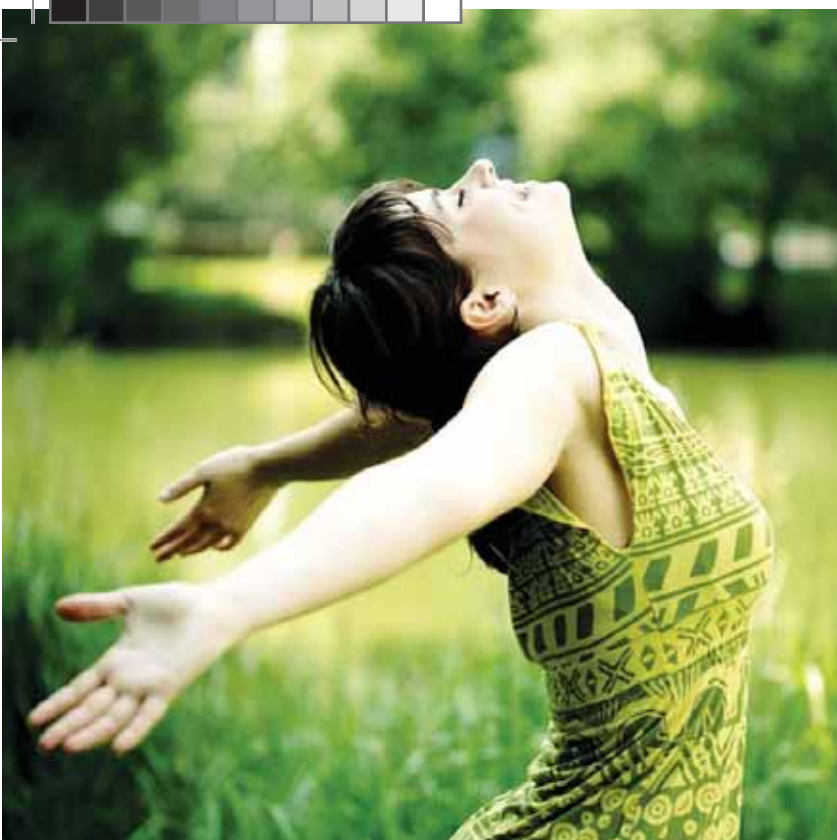
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## *What makes you happy?*

## *Invest in relationships...*

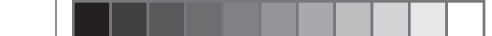

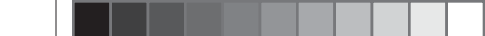
