






Editor's LETTER

However, if you find the sizzling temperatures of the UAE just a little too unbearable for extended periods of time, then we're pleased to tell you that you're not alone. When we go to the pool with our girlfriends, we're more into sipping cocktails and having a girlie catch up in cool and slightly shady areas, as opposed to baking in the sun – and that's totally okay!

We love having a year-round summer glow, and have found that when we can't quite hack the UAE sun – or when we just want a little bit of extra or instant help – then faking it is the way to go. TANNING TIP: Make sure skin is clean and exfoliated prior to application, and moisturise dry areas such as knees and ankles. Go hard on other areas of the body, but go soft on the dry areas we mentioned. We like applying fake tan to hands with a make-up brush, with a very light hand. Alternatively, simply brush over hands with your tanning mitt – don't add any extra product – and ensure palms remain tan-free with a make-up removing wipe or dedicated fake tan removing wipes.

tan!

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
Clarins - Liquid bronze self tanning for face and d collet, £20, Debenhams








■ At the 'The Greatest Showman' World Premiere in Viktor & Rolf






It will help your reduce your carb intake and increase the protein.
