

UNVEIL THE MISS UNIVERSE POWER OF UNITY CROWN




World-renowned luxury jeweller Mouawad unveiled The Miss Universe Power of Unity Crown, crafted by Mouawad, at an exclusive press event at the Atlanta Marriott Marquis today ahead of its grand debut at the 2019 MISS UNIVERSE® competition on Sunday, December 8, at 7 p.m. ET/7 p.m. PT on FOX and Telemundo. The crown is valued at approximately \$5 million USD.

Taking its inspiration from the universal themes of nature, strength, beauty, femininity and community, the crown was created with 18-karat gold and handset with more than 1,770 white diamonds and three golden canary diamonds. These hundreds of diamonds are set in intricate motifs of petals, leaves and vines, representing the communities of women from around the world whose bonds unite them and remind us we are stronger together than apart. The crown's centrepiece, a shield-cut golden canary diamond weighing a magnificent 62.83 carat, and its harmony with the diamonds surrounding it, symbolizes the golden age of women, where they are celebrated for being strong, complex, diverse and unapologetically ambitious.

"The interconnected vine motifs set with diamonds are symbolic of how through forging bonds among communities around the world, we can empower one another to become a force for good," said Mouawad Co-guardian Fred Mouawad. "Likewise, the crown's name, 'Power of Unity,' is a message to the world to unite in the cause of humanity". The stunning centrepiece diamond and the other two golden canary pears either side were cut by Mouawad from the same rough, sourced from Botswana.

"The three golden canary colored diamonds in the crown were selected





to symbolize the optimism created when communities come together to build a better future," said Mouawad Co-guardian Alain Mouawad. Mouawad Co-guardian Pascal Mouawad said, "With its powerful message of beauty and unity, the Mouawad Miss Universe Crown is an inspiring work of art and a testament to Mouawad's passion for crafting the extraordinary. It has been an incredibly rewarding experience to watch this first Mouawad Miss Universe Crown come to life and now be unveiled to the world".

The Miss Universe Power of Unity Crown, crafted by Mouawad, made its appearance in front of the world when Miss Universe 2018 Catriona Gray crowned her successor Miss Zozibini Tunzi, in the live televised event, on Sunday December 8.

Coloryour Naturally Top Five Way to Color Hair **Naturally**

Natural is the hot new trend this summer, as people revert to their original shiny healthy hair that is a classic, timeless color. Although a number of celebrities can be seen sporting their babyblue strands, rainbow wisps, cinnamon swirls, lilac tresses or neon colors that make a statement but the tendency is to opt for dipped ends and highlights. A major reason is the heavy cost in terms of the lost texture and the amount of chemical exposure for the scalp. Coloring one's hair, without resorting to chemical dyes, seems like a difficult proposition but what is the natural alternative... A renowned figure among celebrities, and a regular on red carpets,

the name Asgar Saboo is synonymous with headline grabbing, style-worthy hair. He is trusted by A-list stars such as Aishwarya Rai Bachchan, Katrina Kaif, Deepika Padukone and legend Rekha as well as supermodels Cindy Crawford, Twiggy and Hollywood actress, Eva Longoria. His work, cuttingedge and sophisticated hairstyles and his hair creations have been showcased at glittering premieres, showbiz events and multiple awards ceremonies. The UK based hair maestro Asgar Saboo, shares with us a step by step guide on how to create gorgeous hue's with natural elements, for an unaffected style that's perfect for the summer sun.

The Dark Coffee Tint

If you naturally have dark hair or even a lighter hue but want to go a shade darker this summer, coffee is the perfect solution for a natural home DIY hair dye. It may require two or more applications but the advantage of using coffee is that coffee helps with hair growth, it adds shine to dull hair and after a one hour application, the hair will be much softer.

How to:

- 1) Mix 2 cups of leave-in-conditioner with 2 table spoons of organic coffee grounds and 1 cup of cold brewed coffee.
- 2) Prepare a few cups to cover the whole head.
- 3) Pour over clean hair & cover with a shower cap. Let it sit for about an hour. If you want a darker shade, then leave the hair dye on for a longer period of time or even overnight.
- 4) Afterwards, use apple cider vinegar to rinse the coffee out of the hair. This will also help seal in the color. Finally, rinse with warm water
- 5) Repeat the process twice a week until hair reaches the desired shade and follow up every week or two to freshen up the color.





The Lightening Lemon Mix

This lemon mix works best when the sun is out and can naturally dry the mixture into the hair. The sun also works as a natural highlighter by taking away the melanin that gives hair its pigment. This is the no fail remedy for lighter locks in the summer. The benefit of using lemon is that it acts as a cleanser for hair and for oily scalps, it can help reduce the extra oil, while getting rid of any dandruff.

How to

- 1) Use one cup of freshly squeezed lemon juice with three cups of strong chamomile tea
- 2) Soak hair in the mixture and let your hair dry in the sun & then rinse the hair out
- 3) Choose a good nourishing conditioner after rinsing, as lemon can dry out the hair.
- 4) Repeat this 2-3 times per week for best results. Tip: If you desire highlights in your hair, divide the hair and drag the mixture through chosen sections. The lemon will just add highlights to the areas covered by the mix.



The Nourishing Henna Dye

Henna is a natural dye and hair treatment that is very popular in Asian countries. Henna contains compounds that stain the hair or skin a dark red or brown color and this makes it a wonderful, natural hair dye. Although after using henna, the hair cannot absorb color from conventional dyes. However, as a natural ingredient it nourishes the hair making it beautifully silky and smooth and at the same time it has the same benefits as coffee or lemon.

How to:

- 1) Brew natural henna powder to a dense, muddy paste
- 2) Essential oils, vinegar and even eggs can be added to make the henna even more potent and nourishing for the hair.
- 3) Apply this mixture to the hair and leave on for as long as possible. To get a deeper color, leave on overnight with a shower cap to protect other materials from getting the henna stain.
- 4) Rinse out and condition.





The Beautiful Beetroot and Carrot Juice Soak

If you were not lucky enough to be born with red hair, it is very hard to achieve a natural red by using dyes. Beetroot vegetable juice allows you to have a beautiful natural rich red without the dye or the damage; it is particularly effective in preventing hair loss.

How to

- 1) Combine equal parts beetroot juice and carrot juice. If a deeper red is preferred use more beetroot or if a softer red is desired use slightly more carrot.
- 2) Massage the mixture into your hair and cover with a shower cap.
- 3) Apply heat from a hairdryer for a few minutes to set the color. The longer you leave on the deeper the color will be.
- 4) Rinse out and condition



The Everyday Vinegar Rinse

Like Lemon, vinegar acts as a natural lightener over a period of time and it can give you beautiful results in the summer. Vinegar, in addition to cleansing the hair, which means it will remove scaly-build up, it has a tonic action which promotes blood flow in the capillaries that irrigate the skin.

- 1) Mix a 1:1 ratio of apple cider vinegar with distilled water.
- 2) Pour into an empty hair spritz bottle.
- 3) Spray all over to lighten all of your hair or apply with a brush for strands of highlights.
- 4) Leave on 30 minutes and rinse out. Tip: You can also use with baking powder in your daily shower routine instead of using shampoo. These natural dyes nurture the scalp to promote hair growth; they cleanse hair and remove build-up of from shampoos and other chemical products, they help remove bacteria or fungus that cause dandruff or itchy scalps and finally they leave the hair shiny, smooth and fresh








At 2019 Lucy In The Sky' Toronto Film Festival Premiere

ASHLEIGH BARTY AND BARBORA STRYCOVA SECURE WTA YEAR-END WORLD NO.1 RANKINGS PRESENTED BY

DUBAI DUTY FREE



The WTA (Women's Tennis Association) announced today that Ashleigh Barty and Barbora Strycova have earned the 2019 WTA Year-End World No.1 Singles and Doubles Rankings presented by Dubai Duty Free.

Australia's Barty has clinched the year-end WTA singles No.1 ranking for the first time in her career, becoming the 14th WTA player since the inception of computer rankings in 1975 to achieve the accolade. Strycova has earned this season's year-end No.1 doubles ranking also for the first time, and 2019 marks the second year in a row a player from the Czech Republic has achieved the honor, after Barbora Krejcikova and Katerina Siniakova ended 2018 as the co-ranked No.1 team. "On behalf of Dubai Duty Free, I'd like to offer our congratulations to Ashleigh Barty and Barbora Strycova on achieving the WTA Year-End World No.1 singles and doubles rankings for the first time in their careers," said Colm McLoughlin, Executive Vice Chairman & CEO, Dubai Duty Free. "Ashleigh and Barbora have written their names into the history books in 2019 following their debut Grand Slam titles at Roland Garros and Wimbledon respectively, which was just one of many amazing achievements this season, and I look forward to welcoming them to the Dubai Duty Free Tennis Championships next

Barty became the 27th player to reach the WTA World No.1 ranking on 25th June 2019 and including her triumphant week at the Shiseido WTA Finals Shenzhen, has amassed 15 weeks in the top spot. Her ascent to the World No.1 ranking over the summer also marked the first time an Australian woman had held the position since Evonne Goolagong Cawley reached this historic milestone on April 26, 1976. "To be able to call myself the Year-End World No.1 singles player is one of the proudest moments of my career," said Barty. "This achievement is truly a team effort, and I would not be receiving this honor or had the best season of my life without the people around me

who have supported me on this incredible journey."

Barty has enjoyed a standout season on the WTA Tour, which saw her lift her career-first WTA Premier Mandatory title at the Miami Open presented by Itaú, her maiden Grand Slam title at Roland Garros, and subsequently became the first player to qualify for the Shiseido WTA Finals Shenzhen, where she lifted the trophy after defeating reigning champion Elina Svitolina in the final.

Strycova meanwhile also lifted her maiden Grand Slam title this year, partnering with Hsieh Su-Wei to triumph at Wimbledon. The team also lifted the trophy at the Dubai Duty Free Tennis Championships, Mutua Madrid Open and the Nature Valley Classic (Birmingham), and closed out their season with a runner-up finish at the Shiseido WTA Finals Shenzhen. She ascended to the World No.1 doubles ranking on Monday July 15, 2019, becoming the seventh woman representing the Czech Republic to achieve the No.1 doubles ranking, and is the 43rd woman overall to reach the top spot in doubles. "This is an incredible moment in my career, and I'd like to thank Hsieh Su-Wei who has been my partner for much of this season and helped me reach this goal," said Strycova. "It's been a fantastic year for me and to finish the year as the top doubles player is an amazing feeling." "Ashleigh and Barbora have both enjoyed incredible seasons and we are delighted to see them receive their WTA Year-End World No.1 trophies," said Micky Lawler, WTA President. "I would also like to offer my ongoing thanks to Dubai Duty Free for their association with the WTA Year-End No.1 awards as well as their continued support for




