Designed with impossible intricacy and remarkable savoir-faire, this outstanding work of art stirs the emotions and captivates with its unworldly charm.





BEHIND THE DESIGN

To create the Love in Mist diamond and sapphire suite, a team of expert designers and adept artisans united their knowledge and talent in an exhaustive creative process. From the initial designs, presented in the form of gouache drawings, to the development of the three-dimensional models and the production of the pieces, experts worked closely so that the creative spirit of the original sketches could be transformed into an exceptional work of art.

For this stunning ensemble, Mouawad designers drew inspiration from the first days of springtime, when blooming flowers of all colors announced the subtle awakening of nature from its sweet winter sleep. Insights were then brought to life through a stunning selection of one-of-a-kind sapphires set amidst round, marquise, pear-shaped, and baguette white diamonds interwoven together with 18-karat white gold.

Poise and harmonious appeal were also two main strands of the design process. The masterful arrangement of blue sapphires, each enlivening a shimmering backdrop of icy white diamonds, created an eye-catching effect of color and a stunning, almost blinding, radiance of light. The result is a unique, show-stopping masterpiece, only possible by Mouawad.

SAPPHIRE

One of the Big 3 of colored gemstones, sapphire is a durable stone that captures jewelry buyers with its practicality and aura of romance. Traditionally, sapphire symbolizes nobility, truth, sincerity, and faithfulness. The stone comes in a variety of colors, but when the word 'sapphire' stands alone, this usually means that the gem is blue. Blue sapphires lie well hidden in just a few places around the world, and, in addition to their size, color, and transparency, their origin plays a key role in determining their value. The first sapphires were found in Ceylon (now Sri Lanka), where people were already digging for gemstones in ancient times.




Eyes are the most attractive feature on the face...and the most expressive; they reflect your inner being. Our stressful lifestyles, sleep deprivation, constantly working in front of digital screens, have all added up to weariness and dullness, as well as dark circles, puffiness redness, itchiness and wrinkle in our eyes redness, itchiness and

wrinkles in our eyes. In order to look your best, your eyes need care and attention. We have some very inexpensive eye care tips for you, to take care of your eyes. We have compiled a list of natural remedies as well as some make up tricks, to amp up the look of your eyes and let them take over in conversation when words fail...

Dark Circles and Puffness be Gone

Dark circles and puffy eyes are the biggest problem faced by just about everyone. The best remedy to rid yourself of those nasty dark circles and puffy eyes is by using products rich in vitamin C, which decreases melanin production, and vitamin K, which breaks down pigment particles in the blood. Also keep an eye out for creams loaded with caffeine, which flush out unwanted fluid from the eye contours and a vasoconstrictor, meaning a product that makes capillaries look smaller and less noticeable. Another easy way to care for those tired eyes is by using tea bags whether black, green or white, by placing them over your eyes, they will reduce puffiness and will get rid of the dark shades around the eyes.





Treat Crow's Feet

The skin around the eyes is especially thin and has fewer elastic fibers, so it shows signs of again and dryness more readily other parts of the body. To help get rid of the crow's feet use ultra-rich eye cream like, Strivectin-sd eye concentrate for wrinkles or La Mer - The Eye Balm Intense, which is brewed with hydrating algae and sea kelp. Dryness can aggravate the appearance of eye wrinkles, so use your eye cream in the morning and before bed time. Vitamin B and especially biotin, can help eyelashes and the hair on the head grow, a biotin actually cause eyelashes to fall out. The best way to consume nutrients is by eating them, so boost your biotin intake with foods like nutritional yeast, liver, cauliflower, salmon, bananas, carrot, eggs yolks, sardines, legumes, and mushrooms—all rich in biotin. Curled lashes also make your eyes look bigger and more beautiful in seconds. Always use an eyelash curler before applying your mascara.



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Covering Up Dark Circles

To lighten up those dark circles, concealers, by far, are the best make up product. When applied correctly, it instantly makes you look fresh for a light hyaluronic acid, which attracts moisture to keep eyes looking fresh not dry or dull. If, your under

eye area is prone to creasing, use moisturizing eye primer before concealing. Always remember to apply the concealer where the actual dark circles occur, which is typically a semi-circle, from the interior of the eye, down towards the cheek. For best results use a concealer that has more of a yellow base, in a tone that's a bit lighter than your skin color.




Reduce Red Eyes

Bloodshot eyes can instantly take your well pampered looks, from fresh to fatigued which is actually very unhealthy and less appealing. Use "natural" tear products and eyewashes to provide relief from the symptom of bloodshot eyes. These are inexpensive and widely available over-the-counter. As soon as your eyes get that dry feeling, a couple of lubricating eye drops will make you feel refreshed. They also help rinse the eye, of irritants, but don't make it habitual by using it too frequently, so use sparingly.

Remember to never sleep with your makeup on. Get all your makeup off. If there are traces of mascara on your lashes after you've washed your face at night, the mascara will slide into the eye area while you're sleeping and cause irritation and redness. Eyes are very sensitive, even the slightest reason can cause bloodshot eyes. It is important to pay attention to what is causing the problem and adjust accordingly!





Smoky Eyes Effect

Smoky eyes always look dramatic and require low-maintenance efforts. To get it right, draw a chocolate-colored kohl to line the eyelid, using the side of the pencil not the tip creating a soft

smudgy effect. Next an eye shadow in a similar shade as your eyeliner, and apply it right above the lash line, gently sweeping upwards at the outer corner and blend. The key to getting the ultimate smoky eyes is blending. Finish by applying a soft copper or gold shadow in the inner corners of your eyes to add dimension.


Style crushing on...

SCARLE JONASSON

The world's highest-paid actress since 2018, she has made multiple appearances in the Forbes Celebrity 100. Her films have grossed over \$14.3 billion worldwide, making Johansson the third-highest-grossing box office star of all time. She is the recipient of numerous accolades, including a Tony Award and a BAFTA Award, as well as nominations for two Academy Awards and five Golden Globe Awards. Scarlet Johansson was just fourteen years old when Robert Redford chose her to play the female leading role in his film, "The Horse Whisperer". Even at that time, Scarlett Johansson had four years' experience of acting and drama, as her career really began at the age of ten. Since then she has appeared in a number of successful movies that have been directed by La crème de la crème amongst movie makers. Actress, Scarlett Johansson is seen in roles where her femininity is accentuated, whether in the period pieces like, 'Girl With a Pearl Earring' and 'The Other Boleyn Girl', or Woody Allen's films such as 'Match Point and Vicky Cristina Barcelona', she has been praised for her subtle expressiveness, her ability to convey pensive moments and in spite of that subtlety, articulate a siren-like, bold and aggressive flirtatiousness, in the characters that she portrays. She has won awards from the New York Film Critics Association, Boston Society of Film Critics, Toronto

Film Critics as well as BAFTA award for actress in a leading role, among others. Another accolade frequently awarded to Johansson is that of, 'The Sexiest Woman on Earth', a title given to her by some of the most prestigious glamour magazines in the world. The First Avenue magazine caught up with her while she visited Paris to attend some of the shows presented at the fashion week. The stunningly beautiful actress reveals in a candid interview to First Avenue, her views about fashion, directors, and being the sexiest woman on earth.

In 2010, Johansson debuted on Broadway in a revival of A View from the Bridge, which won her a Tony Award for Best Featured Actress, and began portraying Black Widow in the Marvel Cinematic Universe with Iron Man 2. She voiced an intelligent computer operating system in the drama Her (2013) and a python in the adventure film The Jungle Book (2016), and starred as an alien in Under the Skin (2013) and a woman with psychokinetic abilities in Lucy (2014), both science fiction films. She received critical praise and nominations for two Academy Awards for playing a single mother in Nazi Germany in the satire Jojo Rabbit and an actress going through a divorce in the drama Marriage Story (both 2019).

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


Chanel



Get fit, blast calorie load, and have some real fun outside!



ANNUAL SALES SOAR TO DHS7.406 BILLION (US\$2.029 BILLION)



The New Year began on a high note for Dubai Duty Free with the operation announcing record annual sales of Dhs7.406 billion (US\$2.029 billion) for 2019.

It was clear that a remarkable year was coming to a close in December when the retailer crossed the US\$2 billion milestone on 26th December. The operation's 36th Anniversary Day on December 20th, when customers were offered a 25% discount on a range of products, resulted in a huge surge in sales with 190,208 transactions recorded on the day amounting to sales of Dhs111.65 million (US\$30.59 million) in the 24-hour period.

Reflecting on the year at Dubai Duty Free, Colm McLoughlin, Executive Vice Chairman & CEO said: "Overall, it has been a fantastic year for the operation and I would like to thank H.H. Sheikh Ahmed bin Saeed Al Maktoum, President of Dubai Civil Aviation Authority and Chairman of Dubai Duty Free for his ongoing support. I also join His Highness in thanking our great team of staff, our suppliers and of course our customers, for their contribution to our growth and success." In 2019, the operation recorded over 24.284 million sales transactions which is an average of 66,500 sales transactions per day, while a total of over 64.578 million units of merchandise were sold. The top five selling categories for the year included Perfumes followed by Liquor, Cosmetics, Tobacco and Electronics. Sales of Perfumes, which rose by 2% over 2018, reached Dhs1.124 billion (US\$307.85 million) and accounted for 15% of the total annual sales. Liquor in second place recorded sales of Dhs1.110 billion (US\$304.24 million) and accounted for 15% of total annual sales. Cosmetics, the third best selling category with Dhs848.74 million (US\$232.53 million) in sales and contributing 11% towards the total revenue, showed an impressive increase of 11% over 2018.

Tobacco came in fourth place with sales amounting to Dhs817.16 million (US\$223.88 million) and accounted for 11% of total revenue followed by Electronics in fifth place with sales of Dhs558.05 million (US\$152.89 million).

Meanwhile, sales in Departures across the operation reached Dhs6.6 billion (US\$1.808 billion) and represented 89% of total annual sales, while Arrivals with Dhs664.23 million (US\$181.98 million), represented 9% of total annual sales.

In addition to its record annual sales, Dubai Duty Free's Executive Vice Chairman & CEO Colm McLoughlin also commented on the retailer's many projects that were completed in 2019 and said: "We have continued to develop our retail offer in all the terminals and that included the opening of a Chanel boutique, a Maison Christian Dior shop and a Gucci boutique. We are also looking forward to the opening of the new 1,100sqm retail space in Terminal 3 Arrivals this month. The new arrivals shop is much more visible to passengers in the baggage area and has a fantastic Liquor retail offer. In addition, we will continue the second phase of the refurbishment of the two FoodPlus shops in Concourse B and Dubai Duty Free will continue to enhance its retail offer within the Fashion category in the second half of the year. "We continue to develop our DDF Leisure business - the Jumeirah Creekside Hotel continues to do well and The Irish Village in Garhoud celebrated its 23rd birthday in October. We opened the third Irish Village in Dubai Studio One Hotel and we will be opening a fourth Irish Village at the EXPO grounds this October," he added. Looking ahead, Dubai Duty Free will continue to maintain its busy events and promotional calendar which includes the Dubai Duty Free Tennis Championships to be held from 17th – 29th February at the Dubai Duty Free Tennis Stadium.


